Definitions

Required	Fulfillment is required to be appointed or promoted to rank, and must be evident in supporting documents	
Preferred	Fulfillment is not required, but will be positively considered if activity is evident in supporting documents	
Not Required	Fulfillment is not necessary. It may be useful, however, to include supporting documents if applicable activities are performed.	

Eligibility

Board certification by an ABMS or AOA member Board is required for all clinically active physicians pursuing the rank of Assistant Professor or higher. Foreign medical graduates with certification by well-established specialty organizations may be considered in special circumstances.
