The School of Medicine at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill invites applications for the position of Director of the UNC Biomedical Research Imaging Center (BRIC). UNC-Chapel Hill has made a major commitment to development of the broad campus-wide Biomedical Research Imaging program, which includes a total of at least 18 faculty and substantial core equipment. This campus-wide program will have faculty from the School of Medicine and other Health Affairs Schools as well as the Departments of Physics, Computer Science, and Psychology in the College of Arts and Sciences. UNC-Chapel Hill has a particularly strong animal models of disease program and animal imaging capabilities, and a commitment to building a strong program in translational research. A new building, which will ultimately house the BRIC, is under construction.

The person in this position will assume a leadership role within the UNC School of Medicine and will have academic appointment(s) congruent with his/her professional background and research focus. The successful candidate is expected to be a strong, productive researcher with a well-developed research program in some aspect of biomedical imaging and a broad interest in different facets of imaging technologies. This position requires an MD and/or PhD degree.
