

The State University of New York Upstate Medical University seeks a Chief, Section of General Thoracic Surgery. The successful candidate will join an established general thoracic surgery practice (no cardiac or vascular surgery) in conjunction with University Hospital and the VAMC in Syracuse. Clinical duties may involve increasing the thoracic surgery presence at other hospitals. The candidate will work in conjunction with the pulmonary medicine division and medical and radiation oncology teams. The position includes leadership of a 3-member section, teaching of medical students and general surgery residents, clinical research, and patient care. There is strong midlevel provider support. Faculty rank commensurate with experience. Applicants should possess strong minimally invasive surgical skills, ability in pulmonary, mediastinal and esophageal surgery and a broad knowledge of thoracic oncology as well as demonstrated leadership and mentoring ability. Applicants must be BC in Thoracic Surgery. Women and minorities are encouraged to apply.
