



**PRESIDENT
MEDICAL COLLEGE OF GEORGIA**

The Chancellor and Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia announce a nationwide search to recruit a new President to the Medical College of Georgia. Reporting directly to the Chancellor of the University System of Georgia, the President is the chief executive officer of the university and is responsible for visionary leadership of strategy and effective management of operations.

The Medical College of Georgia, chartered in 1828 as a single academy to provide instruction in "several branches of the healing art," is the only academic institution in the State of Georgia dedicated exclusively to the health sciences. MCG offers more than 50 academic programs from the advanced certificate to the doctorate in its schools of Allied Health Sciences, Dentistry, Graduate Studies, Medicine, and Nursing. MCG's School of Medicine is the only public medical school in Georgia, the 13th oldest continuously operating medical school in the nation. MCG's School of Dentistry is the sole dental school in the state. MCG enrolls more than 2,400 students and nearly 500 residents with a full- and part-time faculty of 950. Nearly 1,500 community-based practitioners serve as volunteer faculty in support of the university's educational activities. With an annual operating budget of \$632 million, a workforce of approximately 5,000, and an annual economic impact of more than \$1 billion, MCG is a major economic force in the Augusta region and the state.

MCG's research efforts focus on diseases that have the greatest impact on Georgians, including cancer, cardiovascular disease, diabetes, neurological disease, and infection and inflammation. MCG ended FY09 with nearly \$84 million in sponsored research. Nearly 70 percent of that funding comes from the National Institutes of Health.

The Chancellor and Board of Regents are seeking new President of exemplary accomplishment and national stature who will provide the strategic vision to lead the Medical College of Georgia at a time of unprecedented growth, a candidate who is dedicated to building on the significant momentum in place at Georgia's health sciences university. While the search will remain open until a new President is named, interested parties are encouraged to submit their applications and/or nominations to the address below by October 1 to assure optimal consideration.
