**Marion Spencer Fay, Ph.D.**, was Dean and President of Woman's Medical College of Pennsylvania from 1946 to 1963. The National Board for Women in Medicine established an award in her name in 1963 to recognize her pioneering leadership. This national award, now in its 47<sup>th</sup> year, is given annually to a woman physician and/or scientist who has made an exceptionally significant contribution to health care as a practitioner, medical educator, administrator and/or research scientist and who exhibits significant future potential.

### **The Marion Spencer Fay Award**

- Formerly administered by the National Board for Women in Medicine, the award continues under the guidance of the Institute for Women's Health and Leadership of Drexel University College of Medicine, which maintains the traditions of the Woman's Medical College and the Medical College of Pennsylvania that reflect a 160-year legacy of excellence.
- The award recipient will be selected from nominations submitted to a special committee, appointed by the Institute, dedicated to the principles of the Marion Spencer Fay Award.
- The presentation ceremony, attended by distinguished academic, medical and scientific leaders, will be held in Philadelphia on April 27, 2010, in conjunction with the spring session of the Executive Leadership in Academic Medicine (ELAM) Program.
- The award includes a \$10,000 honorarium to support the recipient's work.
