Tufts University School of Medicine (TUSM) and Tufts Medical Center are seeking a distinguished physician for the position of Professor and Chair of the Department of Anesthesia (TUSM) and Anesthesiologist-in-Chief (Tufts Medical Center).

TUSM is noted for its excellence in research and patient care, as well as for providing its graduates with an outstanding foundation in basic and clinical sciences. The Tufts University School of Medicine affiliated hospitals include Tufts Medical Center as well as Lahey Clinic, Caritas St. Elizabeth's Medical Center, Baystate Medical Center, and others.

Tufts MC is the principal teaching hospital of TUSM. The Department of Anesthesia at Tufts MC is an academically oriented department committed to the highest quality of patient service and teaching of residents and medical students. The Department consists of thirty faculty members staffing 23 operating rooms, including an ambulatory surgery center, obstetrics, a number of radiology and cardiology sites and an interventional pain management center. In 2008 the Department of Anesthesia provided 16,000 anesthetics to a diverse patient population including neonatal surgery, trauma, and solid organ transplantation. The Department has a robust residency program and offers fellowships in pediatric and cardiac anesthesia. In its 60 year history, the Department has accumulated a distinguished record of contributing clinical excellence supported by pioneering research and teaching to a full service academic medical center.

The new Chair will be expected to develop and grow strong dynamic clinical programs at Tufts MC, provide leadership within the Department and work collaboratively across the organization, and be committed to the training of residents and the research mission of TUSM and Tufts MC.

Nominees/applicants must hold an M.D. degree, be eligible for a Massachusetts License, qualify for appointment to the rank of Professor and be Board Certified. Interested individuals should have an established reputation for clinical innovation and academic excellence, as well as the leadership qualities and administrative, organizational and management skills to lead a major academic and tertiary care department in the context of the changing health care environment.
