

The University of Colorado Denver School of Medicine seeks nominations and applications for the position of Associate Dean for Integrated Curriculum. The School combines academic education and clinical practice with research in a comprehensive program that takes advantage of opportunities for interdisciplinary studies with other academic programs at the University.

#### Nature of Work

Under the general direction of the Senior Associate Dean for Education (SADE), the 0.50 FTE Associate Dean for Integrated Curriculum is responsible for planning, management and leadership of the School of Medicine (SOM) curriculum of the educational program leading to the MD degree. The Associate Dean will have responsibilities including budgetary management; personnel and resource management; oversight of UME based curricular and educational programs, including leadership for ongoing curriculum redesign; overall office administration and supervision of UME professional and administrative staff.

**Academic Administration and Leadership:** As an institutional leader of the School of Medicine's undergraduate medical educational program, represents UME with: School of Medicine offices, departments and committees; all Anschutz Medical Campus schools and programs; community-based faculty serving the educational programs for the SOM; other medical schools, locally and nationally; accrediting and oversight bodies (LCME, AAMC, NBME) and professional societies and organizations sharing our interests in medical education. The Associate Dean will be responsible for oversight of the School of Medicine's MD educational program components within all SOM accreditation processes.

**Curriculum Design and Implementation:** Responsible for overall design and implementation, including leadership of curriculum change and innovation; curriculum management/assessment, including data driven quality assurance; and reporting and compliance with all accreditation standards.

#### Professional Field

The ideal candidate will have an MD or MD/PhD degree with experience in medical education, excellent communication skills; creative and innovative thinking; and a commitment to medical students. Five years advanced experience in medical education is preferred. The Associate Dean for Integrated Curriculum will have the professional and personal qualities to work effectively with faculty, administrators, and students. The Associate Dean for Integrated Curriculum will be passionate about the education of medical students.
