### **General Dermatology**

### **Cosmetic Dermatology**

We offer a wide range of cosmetic services for our patients:

- Botox injections for unwanted wrinkles
- Chemical peels and microdermabrasion to improve skin texture and reduce surface pigment irregularities
- Sclerotherapy for unwanted leg spider veins
- Injectable fillers for diminishing wrinkles, soft tissue augmentation, and depressed scars

### **Dermatopathology**

In our division of dermatopathology, specialists who are board certified specifically in the microscopic examination of the skin bring a unique perspective to diagnosing, treating and counseling patients, providing them with the highest quality patient care.

## DERMATOLOGIC SURGERY

Our fellowship-trained surgeons and board-certified dermatologists provide a full range of laser and dermatologic surgery care for our patients.

### **Mohs Surgery**

Mohs surgery has proven to be the gold standard for the treatment of many types of skin cancer and offers the highest cure rate for skin cancer patients. Mohs surgery is a highly specialized procedure that allows the surgeon to remove all of the cancer with the smallest defect possible. One hundred percent of the removed tissue is analyzed under the microscope to be sure all the cancer cells have been removed. This outpatient procedure is performed under local anesthesia and is usually followed by reconstruction of the area.

### **Melanoma Surgery**

Drexel Dermatology offers a special approach called “staged excision” as the preferred treatment for melanoma-in-situ. After the surgeon carefully removes the melanoma, he works closely with the dermatopathologists to ensure complete removal of the tumor before reconstruction.

### **General Dermatologic Surgery**

In addition to skin cancer surgery and scar revisions, our physicians remove unwanted moles, cysts, fatty tumors, and birthmarks.

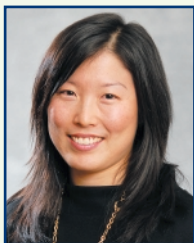
Dr. Allen is board-certified by both the American Board of Dermatology and the American Board of Pathology.
